FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"Without faith it is impossible to please God, since the one who draws near to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him." Hebrews 11:6

This is one of our memory verses on Sunday nights. This verse spurs the question, "What do we believe about God?" This year we have experienced the blessings and promises of God because of our faith. However, God's not finished with us yet. At this moment we have a decision we must make. Henry Blackaby calls it a crisis of belief. It is at this moment that we must decide whether we will get involved in what only God can do or continue to go our own way. This not only applies to the life of the church but also to our personal lives as well. This decision takes faith to fulfill the God sized budget, it takes faith to fulfill the 1st phase of God's vision for our church, and it takes faith to effectively reach this community for the sake of the gospel. It takes faith to accomplish the God-sized vision of fulfilling Acts 1:8. There are times that our faith may waver when we get the news from the doctor, when our circumstances change, or when things just look impossible. Blackaby said, "The way you live your life is a testimony to what you believe about God." I choose to believe God can. When it seems impossible, when it seems out of reach, or when it seems too much, I believe God can. What does your life testify about your belief in God?

Starting this month we have several opportunities to demonstrate our faith in our Savior.

First of all, on May 3rd and May 10th, we have an opportunity to love on the teachers in our community. We need your help starting at 9am on both days. We also need your help in making homemade desserts for this outreach. If you would be willing to help in that area, please contact the church office.

Secondly, we have our children's choir program this coming Sunday. You might say what does that have to do with faith. These children have lines to learn, and songs to remember. This may seem like a small matter, but I know God will be honored and glorified as we worship this coming Sunday morning.

Thirdly, on May 14th we have our baby dedication service. It takes faith to raise, teach, and parent our children. If you are wanting to participate, please contact the church office.

Fourthly, I want to encourage you to mark your calendar for Sunday, May 28th at 5 pm. We will be hosting our first Family Fun Night here at the church. This will be a time of fellowship, food, and bouncy houses for our children. This summer we have several Family Fun Nights planned. Finally, I want to encourage you to continue praying as we move to start phase 1 of God's vision He has given us as a church. Our goal is to have \$60,000 by the end of June. This is only something that God can do. Will you pray about how God wants you to be a part of this ingathering on June 25th? Thus far we have collected nearly \$29,000. Praise the Lord.

May we continue to walk by faith and not by sight.

BBC students began a journey through the book of 1 Samuel in December of 2022. As I write this May newsletter, we are now in the 15th chapter. During the last several months we have compared and contrasted two main characters: Samuel and Saul. Samuel was a man whom God chose to judge and lead Israel. He is what we would call the spiritual leader of God's people. He was a man of conviction and zeal for God's law.



On the other hand was Saul, Israel's political and military leader. Saul was chosen by the people of Israel after they rejected God and Samuel. The book of 1 Samuel describes the tale of a man who chose to do things his own way. He was spontaneous, proud, lacked good judgment, he sought to appear spiritual, but never trusted in the supernatural. Saul, although he was a great military strategist and although he was loved by the people of Israel, was a complete and utter failure. Why?

Saul wanted the approval of men more than the approval of God. Saul could never step out on faith because he didn't have any. He only did the things that would make him look better to those around him. Saul may have been worthy of praise in man's eyes, but in God's eyes he was utterly rebellious.

Why do I bring this up? Church family we can all be guilty of being a Saul. Look around us; God is doing an incredible work right before our eyes. It would be so easy for us to begin looking to ourselves instead of God. It would be easy for us to begin seeking man's approval above God's approval. After trusting God to do a work in our church it would be so easy to replace steps of faith with our own human understanding.

The fact that Israel approved of Saul's leadership and rejected Samuel's was very telling of their spiritual state. What about ours? Have we moved on past the elementary steps of our Christian faith? Are we past the point of caring about what others think of us? Do we seek to honor God above all else? I hope you will search your heart like the book of 1 Samuel has caused me to search mine. I love you, I am thankful for you and I look forward to what this new month has in store.
