"For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also faith apart from works is dead." James 2:26

Rahab, in Joshua chapter 2, risked it all for the sake of the gospel. The reason she risked it all was because she believed God. Listen to this, "If the king had discovered that these Jewish spies were in Rahab's home, she and her family would have been executed immediately." Rahab put her life and everything she loved on the line because of her faith in the Lord. As believers, are we willing to take risks in obedience to the Word of God? Will we go against the grain of culture, even the Christian subculture, for the sake of the gospel? Our faith is displayed by what we believe about God. Every day we have the opportunity to demonstrate our faith, in our homes, our community, in West Virginia, and at our jobs. Are we willing to take some risks for the glory of the Lord?

Will you step outside of your comfort zone and allow God to use you? There are plenty of opportunities for you to live out your faith within our church body.
